Coravin 🗸

A clever little device that lets us pour wine without removing the cork or put in place of the cap. It uses argon gas to serve a glass while keeping the rest of the bottle fresh. Great for trying special and baller drops by the glass.

Organic 🚳

Wines made from grapes grown without synthetic pesticides or herbicides. Organic producers focus on soil health, biodiversity, and working with nature to grow healthy fruit.

Bio-Dynamic Practices 🏟


A small step beyond organic. Biodynamic viticulture follows a holistic, eco-friendly approach that includes lunar cycles, composting, and herbal preparations. It's all about balance: in the vineyard and in the wine.

Vegan 🎾

You might be surprised, but not all wines are vegan! Some use animal-based fining agents to clarify wine. Vegan wines skip these and use plant-based or natural alternatives (no animal products are used in the winemaking process).



Perched at 1050 metres on the northern slopes of Gaanha Bula, De Salis is a family-run winery crafting expressive coolclimate wines with a minimalist, hands-off approach.

Led by winemaker Mitch Svenson, they focus on dry-grown Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and sparkling wines, all fermented with wild yeast and minimal intervention.



Crafted by Zorik Gharibian, who returned to his ancestral homeland to revive Armenia's ancient winemaking traditions, 'Karasi' is a tribute to the country's 6100-year-old viticultural heritage. Sourced from ungrafted Areni Noir vines grown at 1,370 meters above sea level, the wine undergoes fermentation with indigenous yeasts in concrete vats and is aged in traditional clay amphorae, known as "karasi," for 12 months.
